The Winter Solstice occurs December 21st, 2017 at 11:29 AM EST, when the Sun's light shifts into Capricorn. We reach the shortest day at this time, and celebrate Yule, the "return of the light". The Sun in Capricorn cycle for the next 30 days marks a period to increase productivity, stimulate ambition and draw our focus to practical matters. It's time to be more attentive to the effort necessary to reach goals, and to clear a path for progress. And, we learn about limitations, too. This year, the Capricorn cycle begins as the Sun connects to the planet Saturn, adding some definite heaviness to the mix. Have you felt it? From December 23<sup>rd</sup> - January 10<sup>th</sup>, Mercury will cover the same territory it has traveled since November 15<sup>th</sup>.
