
There are huge changes happening in the cosmic scheme. First, two of the “big guys” – Jupiter and Saturn – are shifting out of their cycle in Capricorn – a powerful feature of 2020 – and into Aquarius. When **Saturn moves into Aquarius on December 17th**, the focus of Saturn's testing, challenges and restraints will take on unconventional, inventive, independent, and revolutionary qualities. The needs of the community and commonality we all share can be utilized to strengthen the infrastructures in our lives. Plus, **expansive Jupiter moves into Aquarius' territory on December 19th** (8:07 AM EST). In many ways, Jupiter's freedom-loving energy can be boosted by the influence of Aquarius.

As the **Winter Solstice peaks on December 21st (5:03 AM EST)**, the Sun's light can outshine the communicative networking suggested by the planet Mercury, also beginning its travel through Capricorn on December 21st. ***It's time to clarify the message you want and need to deliver, and to find ways to support the true intention of that message.*** Be aware that ego-infused communication can be problematic, although true leadership will be welcome. The BIG DEAL that’s been taking the headlines, though, is the fact that **Jupiter and Saturn are joining together on December 21st at 1:21 PM** (EST). Jupiter and Saturn form a conjunction about every twenty years, and generally mark a time when major changes in leadership are likely. What makes this particularly Grand Conjunction important to us is the fact that they will come together at the Winter Solstice – something that has not happened for 800 years! For the next two–three weeks, you can watch this cosmic event. Check out the skies just after sunset, and you’ll see these two planets shining brightly, gradually moving closer and closer. This unity, at what is for many an especially sacred time, marks a special opportunity for the evolution of humanity. It is believed by many historians and astrologers that the birth of Jesus occurred during a grand conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn – and has been called the Christmas Star. After all, the Magi were astrologers, and their story is about following that star, which was likely the conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn!

The history of this conjunction is fascinating to explore, and the periods when this joining has happened in the past have had major significance. Now it is time to write a new chapter inspired by the Truths that guide our lives. While



Jupiter in Aquarius suggests a vision for the future inspired by the power of originality and invention, thanks to Saturn’s powerful presence, we are also required to carry the burden of responsibility for our attitudes and actions. Incorporating what we’ve learned from the past while allowing room for fresh and innovative change will be a real test. Given the polarization that has become ever–present, it may not be easy to check our egos at the door while we work together to heal the wounds we have been and are experiencing. The close line–up of Jupiter, Saturn and Pluto that began in late 2019 was the primary factor holding feet to the fire as the deepest transformative processes took the lead. to the surface, begging us to deal with the mandate to release what is toxic and no longer necessary in our lives. Some of those transformations in 2020 have been destructive. Science is providing a way forward through development of vaccines and viral treatment protocols to help us survive this gut-wrenching test. One major theme of Jupiter and Saturn in Aquarius is the reality that we are all in this together ... Very Aquarian. Jupiter will remain in Aquarius until December 30, 2021 (after a brief interlude of Jupiter in Pisces during the late spring-early summer of 2021). Saturn, however, will travel through Aquarius until March 2023. Our opportunities to integrate what we're learning and how we are shaping our priorities can have a distinctive cultural impact. It is a powerful cycle for establishing new ways of interacting that celebrates the bright accomplishments of the individual while moving forward the evolutionary processes of the Collective.

It's a simple premise, but an important one - to remember that we all breathe the same air. Unity and commonality will become ever-present. While the Christmas Star inspires us, the joining of these planetary giants reminds us that we can manifest a brighter vision for a future by working together.

The Lunar Phases for the early Winter season continue to shift, with the **Full Moon in Cancer on December 29th** (10:28 PM EST). The need to connect personally will be very strong during this time, even though it looks like the Covid-19 required restraints in the USA may make that more difficult to be close.
